

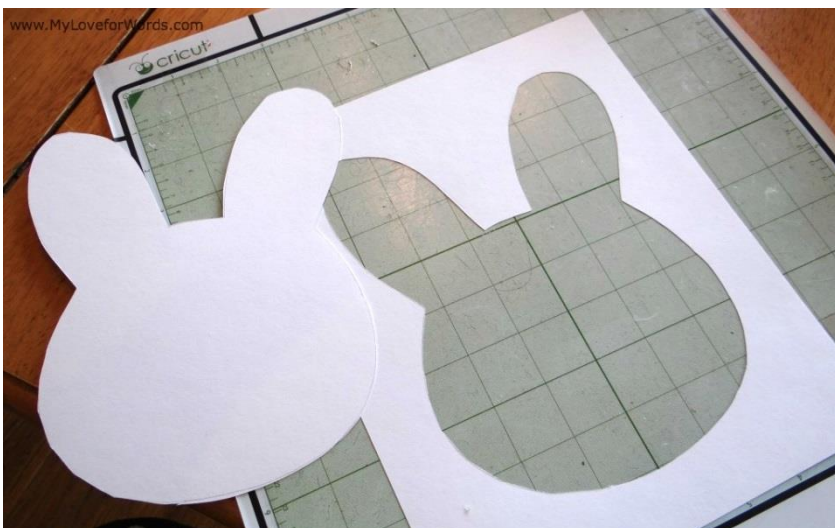
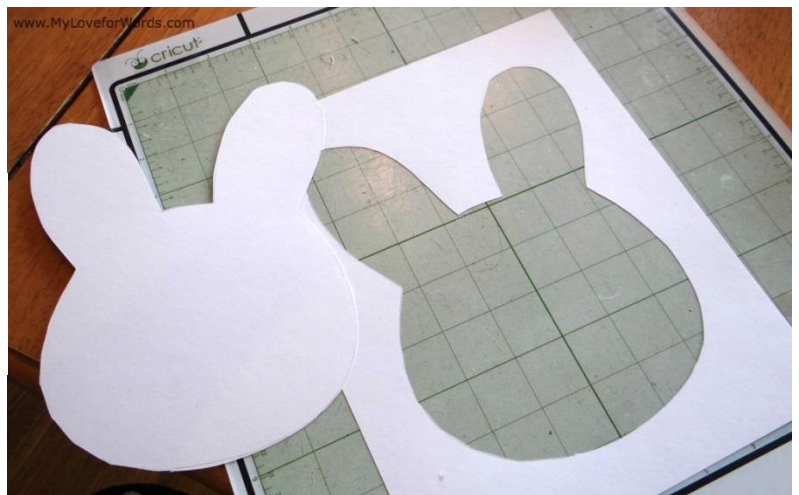
EASTER BUNNY CRAFT



Materials:

- 2 pieces of 8×10cm paper or cardboard (or whatever size is needed for your frame)
- pencil and rubber
- scissors or knife
- recycled newspapers or magazines
- glue
- frame

1) Draw your image on your paper and cut out the design.



2) Put your two pieces of paper together and carefully trace the cut out image on to your second piece of paper. The tracing doesn't have to be perfect. This will just act to give you a guideline to make sure the entire image will be covered by your decorative paper pieces when you're finished.



3) Cut down some random strips of paper from a magazine or a newspaper and glue them over your traced image.

4) Place the paper with the cut out over your covered image. You can also glue your cut out paper on to the striped paper or attach them temporarily with tape or something.



Finally, frame it. This project only takes about 15 minutes, so you can make a different one for every season and change them out as necessary. Easy peasy!

In addition, you can also make different Easter projects using this technique.
