## Simple Past or Present Perfect?

Simple Past	Present Perfect
For actions that happened and <b>finished in the past</b>	For actions which started in the past and <b>continue up to now</b>
For actions that happened in the past and <b>we know exactly when</b>	For actions that happened in the past but <b>we don't know the exact time</b>
With <b>yesterday, then, ago, last night/week..., in 2001..</b>	With <b>for, since, ever, never, yet, already, so far, how long...</b>

### Use Simple Past or Present Perfect:

- .....Helen ever ..... (try) sushi?
- ..... you ..... (go) to the wedding last night?
- I ..... never .....(be) to Paris.
- This year I ..... (travel) to Athens 3 times so far.
- Paul and Judith .....(be) married since 1998.
- ..... you .....(finish) your homework yet?
- Last night aunt Betty .....(come) by. She .....(tell) us that this summer they are going to Hawaii.
- I .....(visit) many different countries so far. Last summer I .....(go) to Italy and 3 years ago I .....(be) in Spain. I .....(not/visit) Germany yet.
- When .....you .....(come) to Greece?
- I..... (come) in 2007.
- .....you ..... (watch) the film E.T. yesterday?
- They..... already .....(leave) the train station.
- How long ..... you .....(know) Jonathan?
- I ..... (meet) him in 2009, so I .....(know) him for 3 years.
- What .....(happen) to Lucy last night?
- ..... you ..... (read) "Harry Potter" when you were on holidays?
